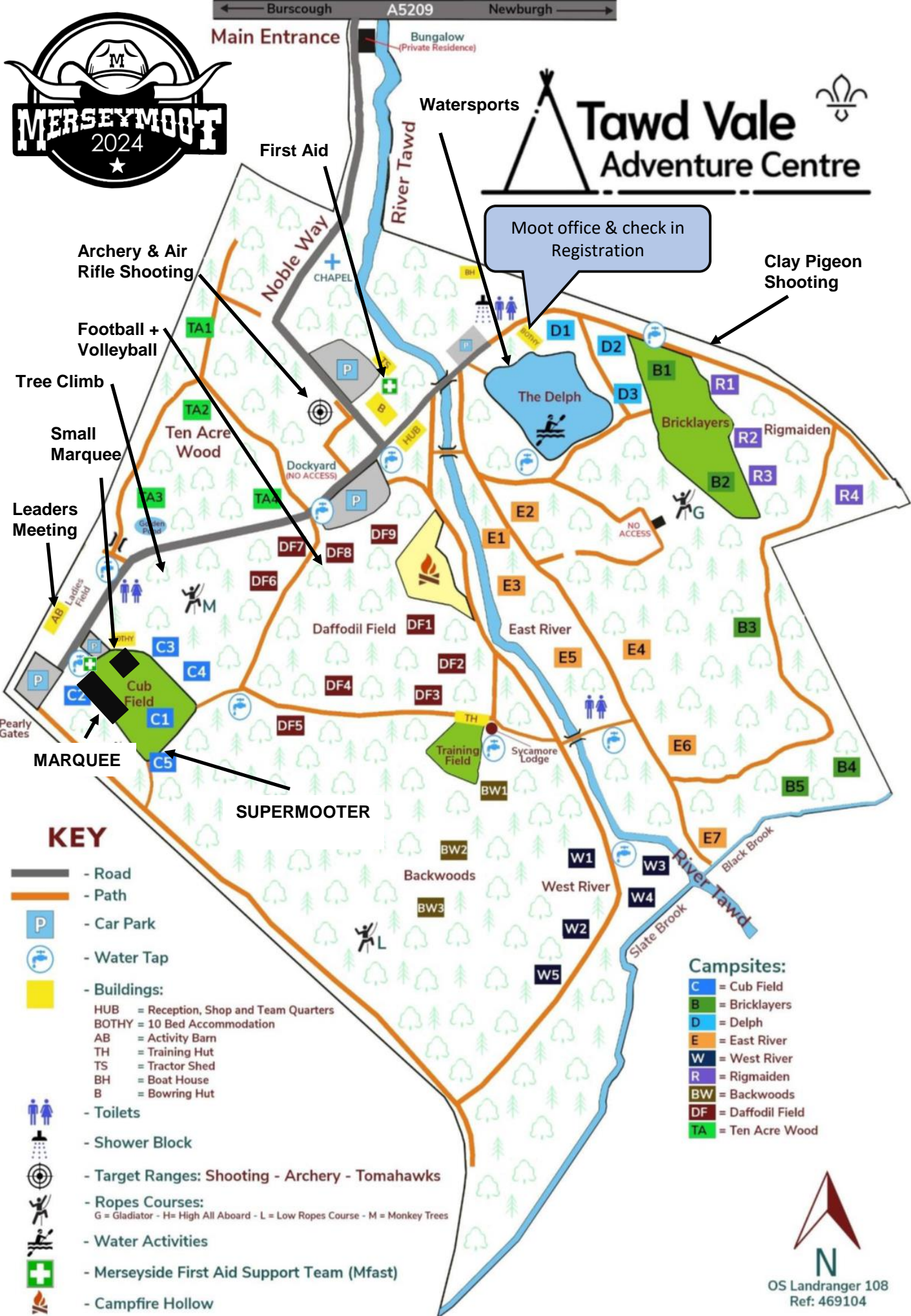

# SUPERMOOTER 2024

## Rules

- A signed slip from leaders needs to be given to registration to confirm a place
- We like as many teams to enter as possible however please have a “first” team and if you would like to enter a second team please do but label it “second”. We will prioritise the first team and then a random draw will be done to fill the remaining places, with the second teams.
- No cheating
- The teams need to consist of both males and females
- Listen to all networkers/ Adults at all times
- Teamwork is mandatory with participants assisting each other at all times.
- No swapping players throughout the event
- No white or transparent clothing, wear appropriate footwear and take care at all times
- No inappropriate behaviour
- (Spectators) all individuals that enter the supermooter zone e.g participants and spectators have to get involved in the activity and that therefore will get wet and muddy.
- Please be aware that all posts, photos, and videos are shared on the Mersey Moot website and Facebook page. Due to the large number of participants, it will be extremely difficult to avoid capturing participants with no photo permission, please consider this when selecting participants for this activity.

## Scoring method

The supermooter is scored using a points system, and the team at the end with the most points, wins.

- **5 points** if the team wins the activity
- **3 points** if the team loses

The networker/adult supervising the activity will award extra points depending on the teamwork and enthusiasm displayed during each small activity

Each networker will be given a small rubber pink flamingo to award to a team that they feel is doing the best teamwork and has the most enthusiasm in their opinion, teams will also have the opportunity to win the pink flamingos during the mini activities.

- Pink flamingos are worth **10 points**
